John Hastings (1923-2010) played baritone horn in the Lancaster Town Band for over thirty years, also serving many years as Vice President. In addition to the Lancaster Town Band, John played for many years in the German-American Musicians Band, with which he toured Germany in 1986, the Buffalo Shrine Band, serving ten years as Band president, the West Seneca Town Band, the Akron Community Band, and the Corfu-Pembroke Community Band. As a college student, he performed in the Northeastern University band in Boston, MA and as a high school student, in the Bradford Academy Band in Bradford, Vermont. John's community service work included many years on the Clarence Concert Association Board, of which he was president for 3 years. In addition, he was an avid listener to all types of music, particularly symphonic music, operas, and band music. An electrical engineer and purchasing manager by profession, music was his all-consuming hobby. John and Jean were married in 1957. Jean enjoyed singing and playing piano in her youth. Their children and grandchildren have continued their musical legacy in bands and orchestras in both the Buffalo area (especially Lancaster Town Band!) and the Chicago area.
