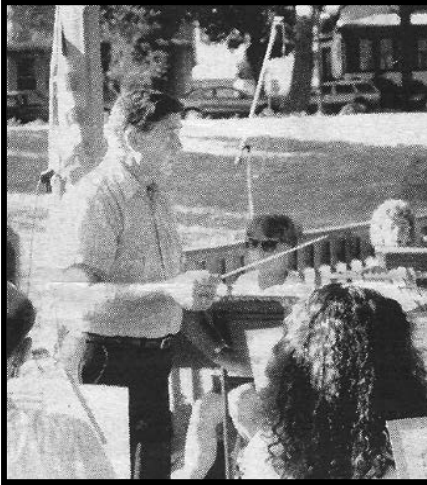

Besides playing the clarinet, Lynda served on our Board of Directors. She was also very dedicated to her role as librarian as she organized folders for our season and always made sure we were prepared.

She was a caring person who always greeted everyone with a smile. Even though she was unable to play this past summer, she never missed a rehearsal or a concert. She would bring her husband David and made sure he was all set to play. Lynda helped with fundraising and sold 50/50 tickets during the concerts throughout last year.

Lynda had optimism and a positive spirit even though she wasn’t feeling well. She always had a contagious smile, a friendly word, and a positive attitude. To honor Lynda and her years of service, we have engraved a brick at the band shell in her memory. She was an important part of our family and she will be missed.
