Phil Blommendahl (1944-2017)

Philip L. Blommendahl transitioned on September 29, 2017 after 73 trips around the sun. He was born on September 18, 1944. Phil is the adopted son of Spencer and Evelyn, who predeceased him. Husband to the late Helen Sarikas Blommendahl, brother of Dale (Shelia) and Karen Blommendahl from California. Father of David (Sadie) Blommendahl. Grandfather of Charlie and her three children by marriage and uncle to 7 and great uncle to 15 in Arizona, California, and the Buffalo area.

Phil began playing drums in 1952 and was an active musician for most of his life. He has played locally in the Amherst Symphony and Lancaster Town Band. He was involved in many facets of the music industry, from spot composing, recording studio work, and playing 'gigs' and performing with community bands. His other interest was that he and his late wife Helen collected teddy bears.

Phil was also an active member of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Amherst.

"If you believe in forever then life is just a one-night stand. If there's a rock 'n' roll heaven, you know they've got one hell of a band." (The Righteous Brothers from the 1970's).

Phil Blommendahl had just moved to Buffalo with his wife, Helen (a Buffalo native) in 2010. He saw a notice in *Gusto* that the Lancaster Town Band was playing a holiday concert in late December. He took note of the number, and with his

wife's encouragement, left a message on my phone that he would be interested in playing in the group, if there was an opening. I made a note of his name and number, and when March personnel calls came around, I remembered his message and called him.

A very emotional Phil thanked me for calling. He told me that his wife had just died in January, and that she was the person who had encouraged him to reach out. He felt he was ready to play again and came to our first May rehearsal.

For the next 7 years, Phil was the heartbeat of the LTB Percussion section, playing timpani, drum set and percussion. His enthusiasm for our band was infectious. He was the first band member to every rehearsal and concert, setting up the percussion for the entire section. He often chatted with many band members during breaks, after concerts, and at social events.


His stories about his experiences as an LA studio musician, professional date player and community band member were always entertaining. In seven years, I think Phil missed three concerts, because he was visiting family.

One of the true highlights of Phil's time with us was August 1, 2017. Phil was our featured soloist for that concert. He performed the classic timpani solo entitled *Timpat*. Phil practiced for weeks on his bedroom pillows, & often consulted me on his ideas for how to best do the sticking or ways to embellish the cadenza. That evening, he was so proud to play a solo with the band, and we were so proud to see him beaming on the front of the stage.

The next week, we performed our summer concert season finale, ending with the patriotic *Stars & Stripes Forever* by Sousa. Phil and I often spoke for a bit at the end of each concert, but that night was especially emotional. We lingered in the shell as we celebrated another successful concert season. We spoke of the great times and about our great band. We were in such a good place, one of those moments that seems timeless - and, in my mind, a bit of heaven on earth.

Heaven has gained a soul with a heart of gold, but the LTB has a broken heart, as we have lost an irresistibly positive force and dear friend.
